Notice of Work in the Borough of Union Beach

Dear Resident:

The Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority (BRSA) will be rehabilitating our interceptor sewer pipelines in your neighborhood. The rehabilitation work will utilize the cured-in-place liner method to minimize disturbances to all residents and businesses. The work area consists of Jersey Avenue, between Rose Lane and Shore Road. During lining work, temporary bypass piping will be installed adjacent to the roadway and there will be limited access to Jersey Avenue. All residents should follow the posted detour signs and local police to NJ State Highway Route 36 for access to Rose Lane, Harris Avenue and Shore Road.

Lining work is expected to begin on Monday, July 22, 2024 and take up to three weeks to complete. Our Contractor's site supervisor will be on-site at all times.
