Anne Marie Friscia, RMC Municipal Clerk. ORDINANCE 2017-256 AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF **UNION BEACH** CHAPTER 12, SECTION 12-7 – DUMPSTER/CONTAINER PERMITS. BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Union Beach, that they hereby amend the Borough of Union Beach Code Chapter 12-7 Dumpster/Container Permits to read as follows: SECTION 12-7.2: Permit Fee shall be \$30.00. SECTION 12-7.3 No dumpster/waste container shall remain on any street or right-of-way for more than thirty (30) days after the issuance of the "dumpster" permit. SECTION 12-7.4 The cost of inspecting and approving the repair shall be a lien upon the property serviced by the dumpster/waste container and/or storage container. Any dumpster/waste container and/or storage container which remains on a public street or right –of-way for more than thirty (30) days or for which the proper safety apparatus is not maintained will be subject to removal by the Borough and the cost of such removal shall be a lien upon the property serviced by the dumpster/waste container and/or storage container. These civil remedies are in addition to and supplementary to fines and penalties imposed pursuant to subsection 12-7.5 SECTION TWO: Any portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance.
